The FSC-STD-20-011 v4.2 standard) provides that CSI consults, acquires and evaluates information, opinions and comments, expressed by the Interested Parties (Stakeholders), regarding compliance with the applicable requirements of the organization requesting this extension, in order to avoid the use of material from non-admissible sources, and in particular:

- Illegally harvested wood;
- Wood cut in violation of civil and traditional rights;
- Wood from forests where high conservation values (e.g. diversity of species, ecosystems and mosaics at landscape level, habitat, critical services, community needs, cultural values) are threatened by management activities;
- Wood from forests in conversion to plantations or in the form of non-forest land use;
- Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.
